## Information for New Members

- 1 **Code of conduct**: The club's code of conduct is detailed in the club's By Law No 1 copy attached
- **Dress requirements**: Club uniforms or neat casual, shorts are permitted. No gum boots or bare feet, no overalls, no singlets or similar are permitted. Hats, caps, balaclavas and helmets are not to be worn on club premises Club By Law No. 2 details the dress requirements.
